We are the local Workforce Development Board, designated by the City and County of San Diego and governed by a community-led, business-majority board. It is our mission to empower job seekers to meet the current and future workforce needs of employers in San Diego County. We accomplish this by researching labor market trends and aligning businesses, educators, labor organizations, public agencies and community-based organizations to deliver and invest funding in quality job seeker and employer services.

## FAST FACTS:

- SDWP is funded by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) through the State of California; the County and the City of San Diego; cities in San Diego County; the business community; philanthropy; and individuals.
- A series of community-led boards and committees thoroughly review and approve all funding decisions and monitor performance.
- Through 20+ partners, SDWP funds 30+ programs annually, serving 70,000+ adults and youth throughout San Diego County.
- SDWP funds a network of 15 America's Job Center of California (AJCC) full-service, satellite and affiliate sites that serve hundreds of job seekers daily, offering 164,000+ services annually.
- SDWP funds work-readiness training programs for 4,200+ young adults.
- CONNECT2Careers, SDWP's youth employment program, addresses high youth unemployment by providing work-readiness training, job coaching and work experiences.
- SDWP is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, public benefit organization.
