Eligible participants must be currently unemployed and have a documented physical, developmental, or mental disability and meet **one or more** of the following:

- Receive public assistance through CalWORKs, SSI or SSDI
- Participate in services with the Department of Rehabilitation
- Participate in county-funded mental health or alcohol and drug related services

We work with individuals that receive services from various community agencies.
