- **Living with a disability (6%)**

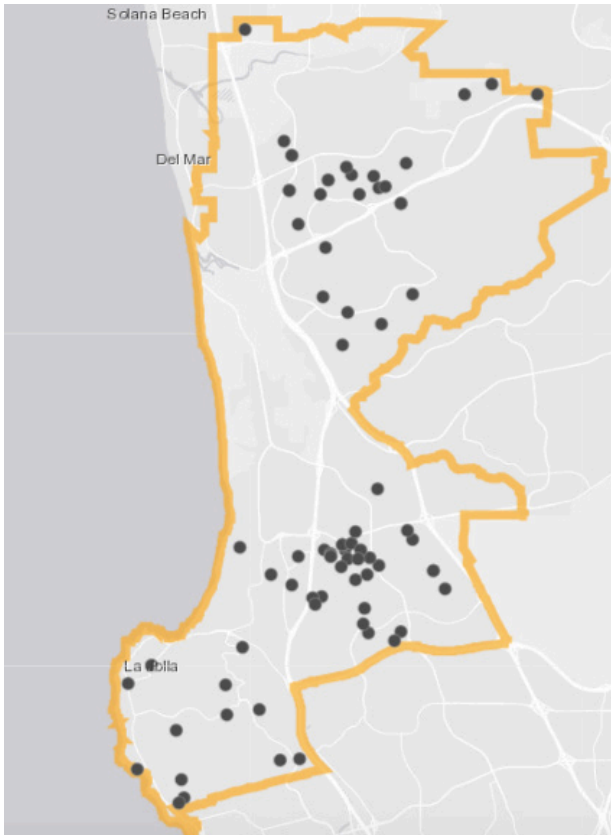
Program spotlight

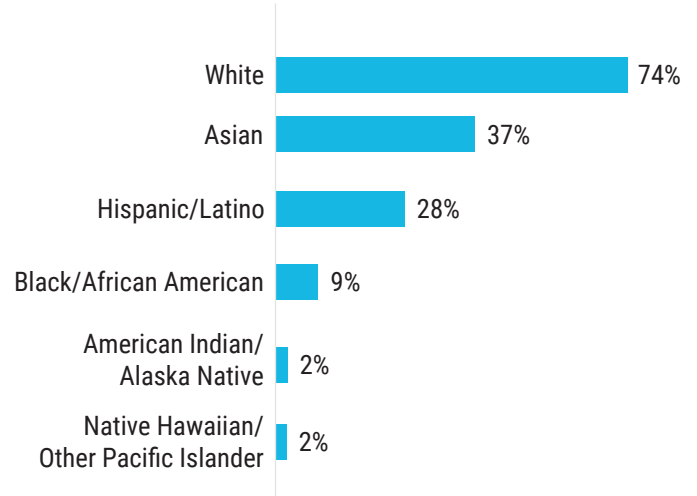

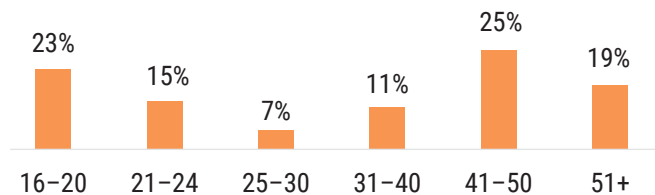
