- **Single parent (8%)**

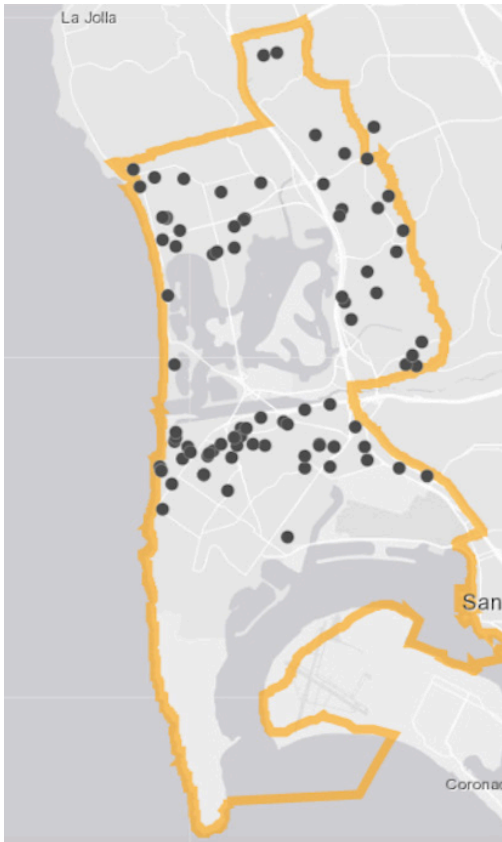
### Program spotlight

In fiscal year 2019, our School Break Externship program subsidized wages for 12 youth to work at the Reuben H. Fleet Science Center during their school breaks.

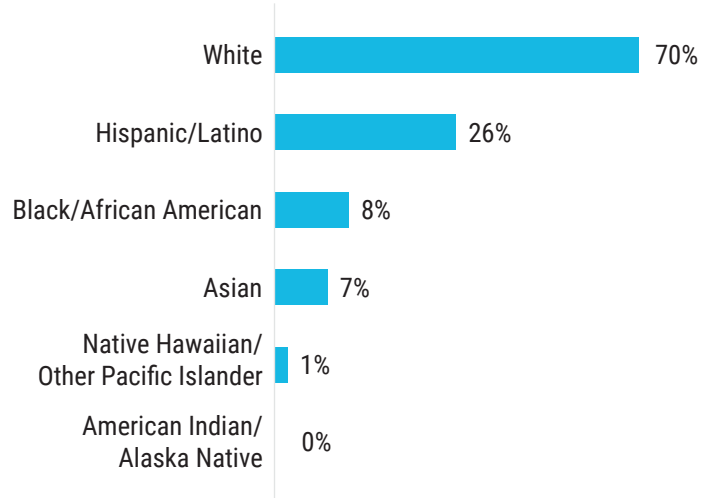

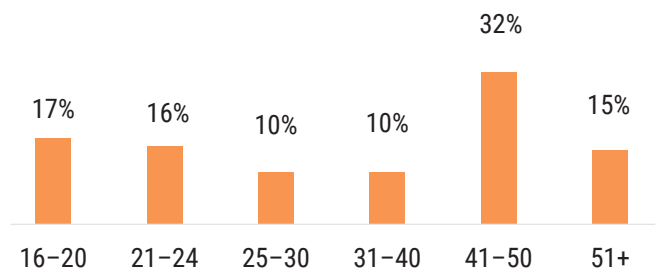
