- **Needs HS Diploma/GED (16%)**

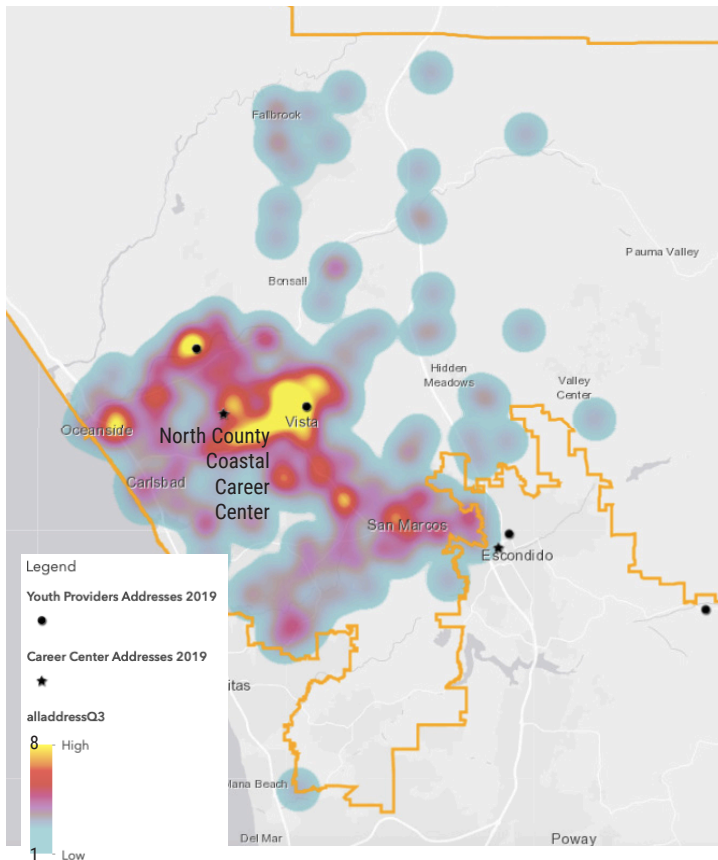
Program spotlight

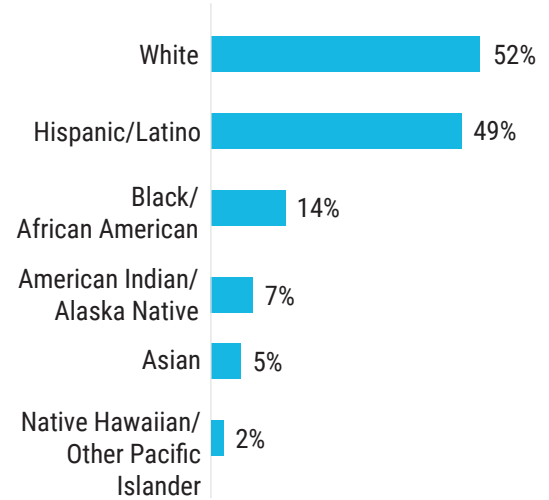

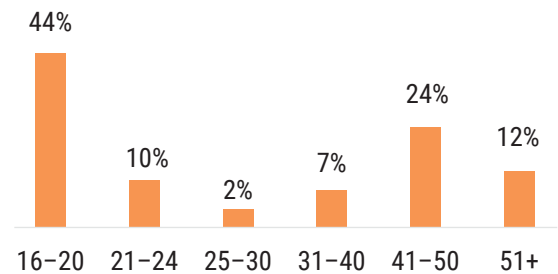
