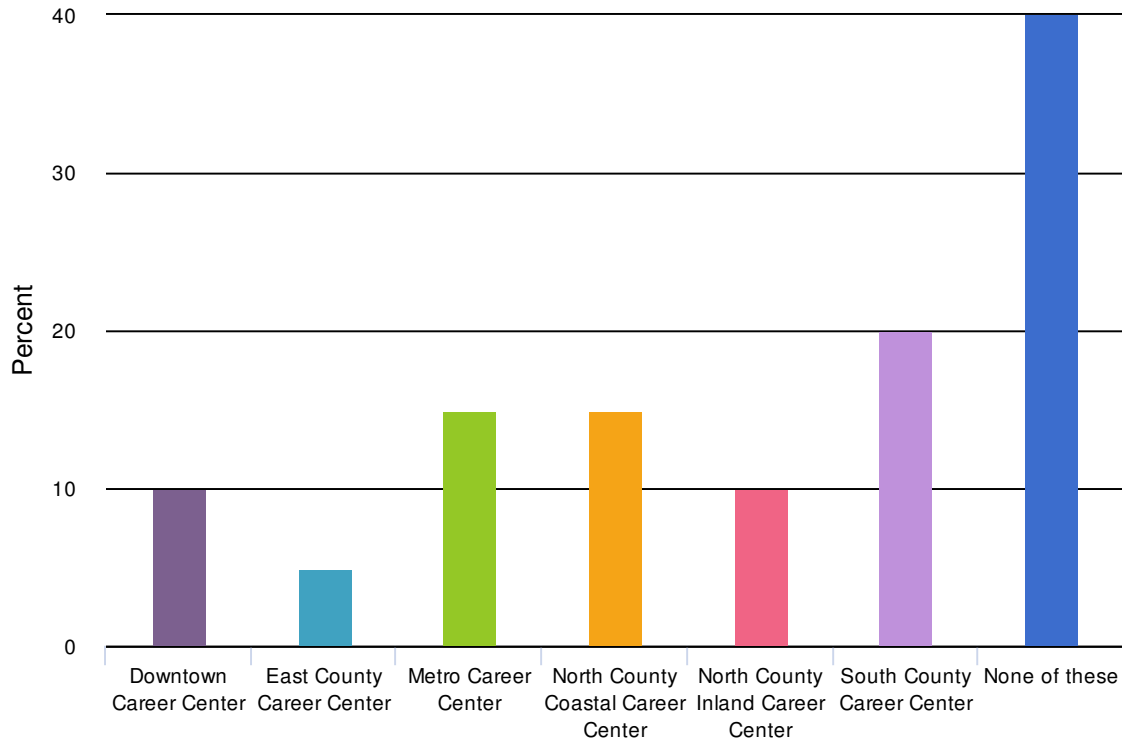

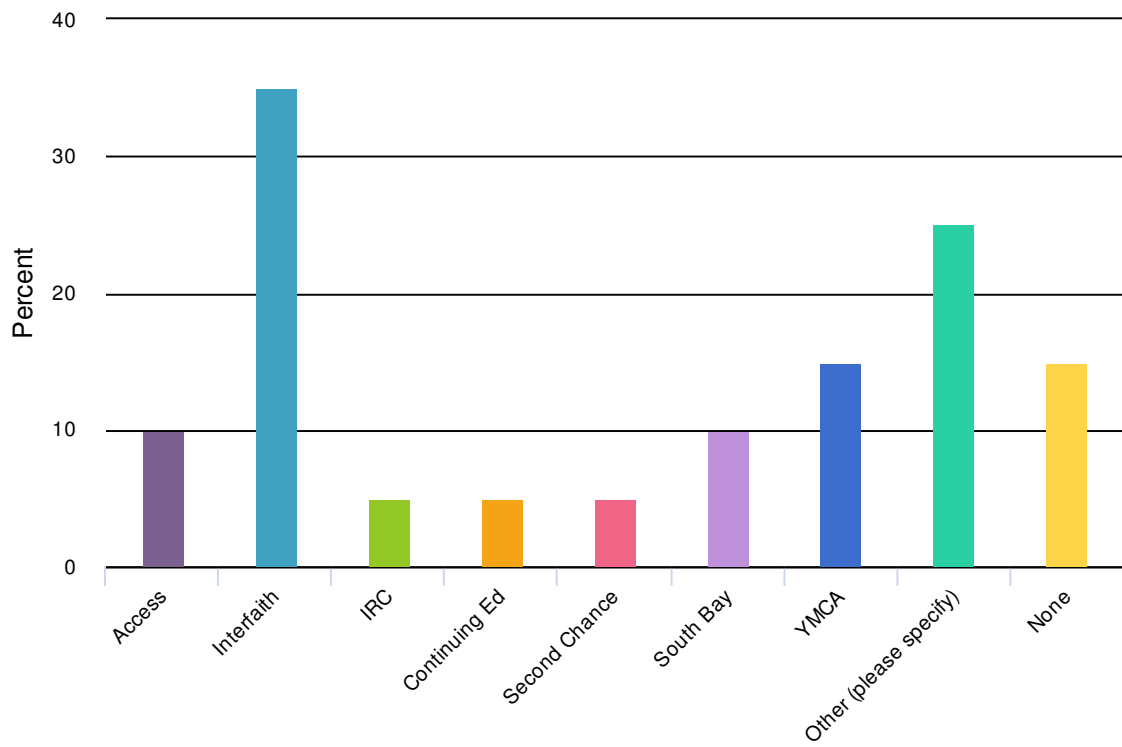

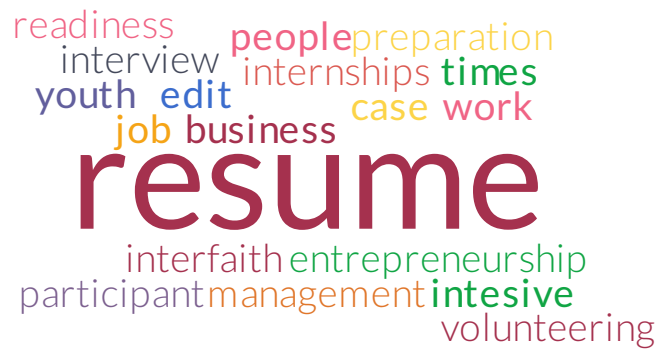

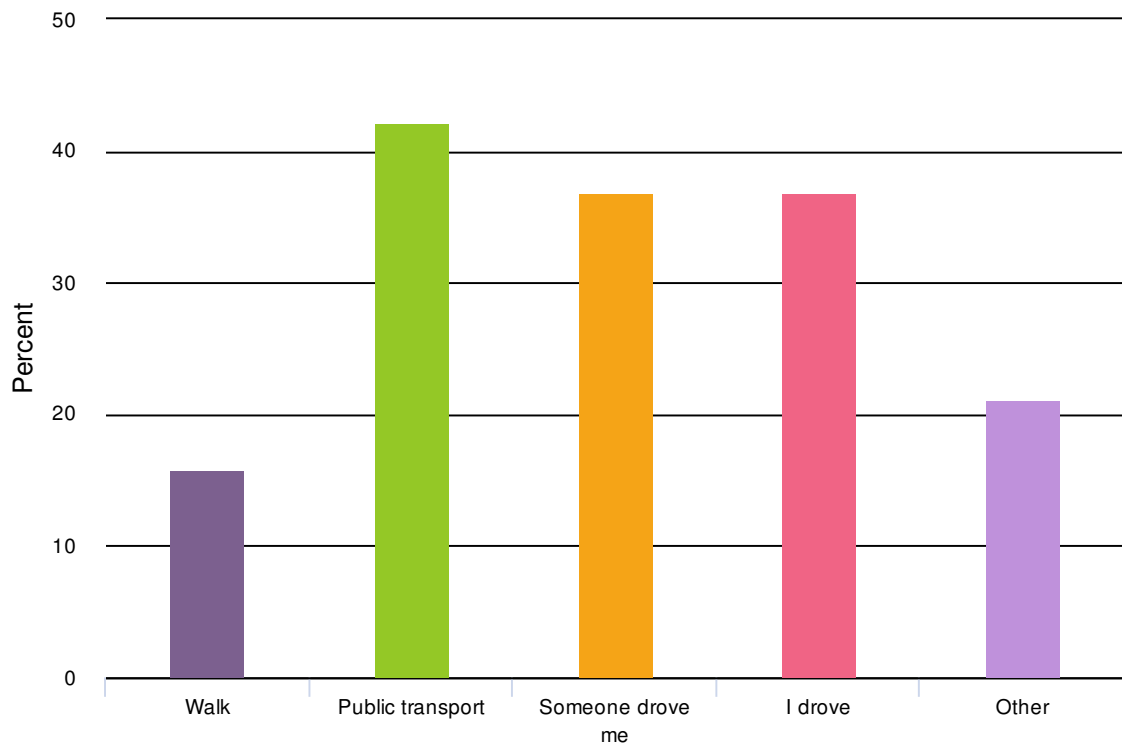

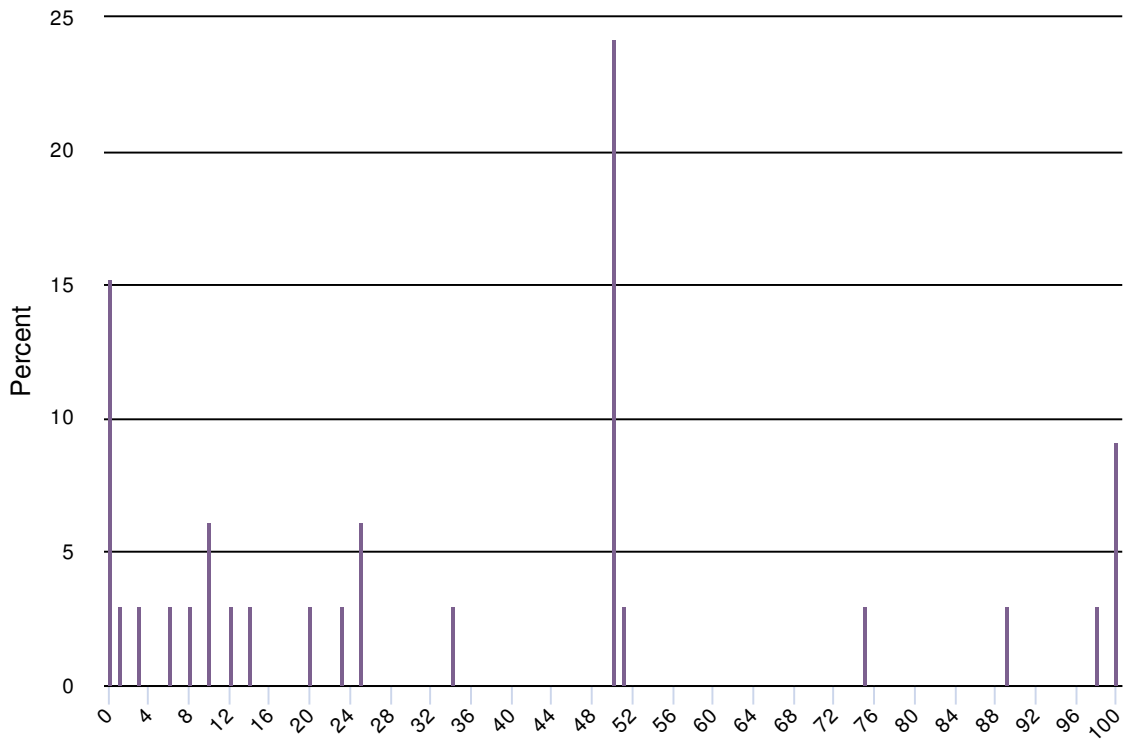

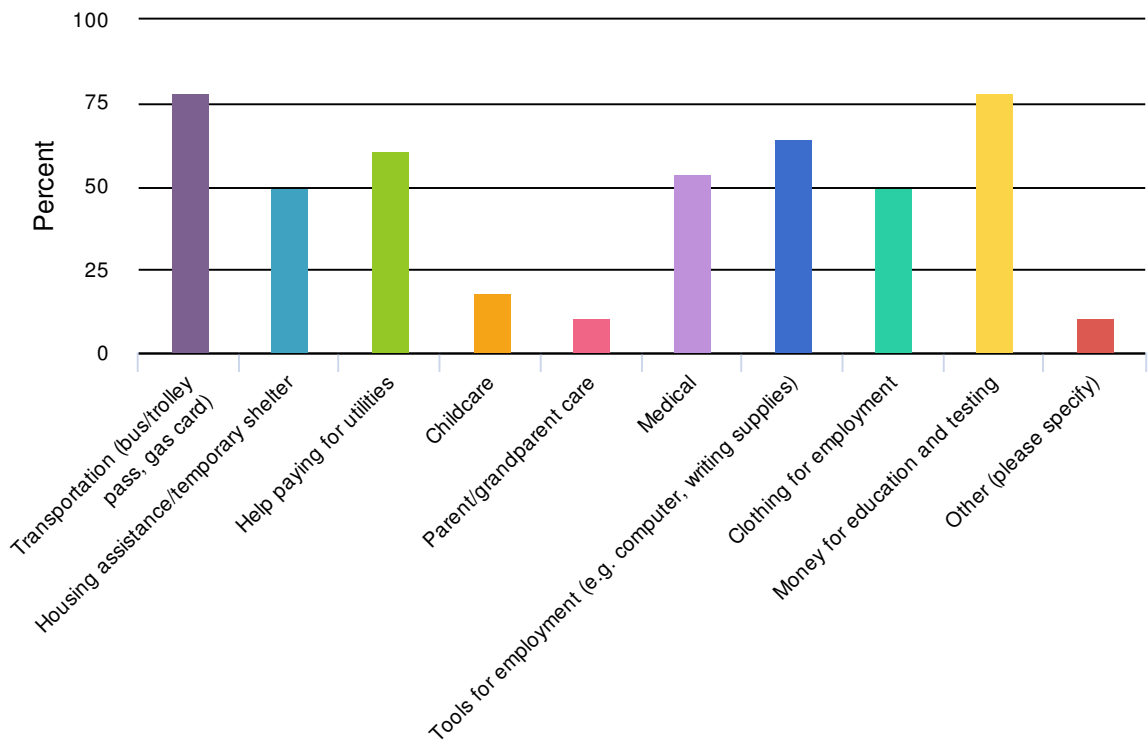

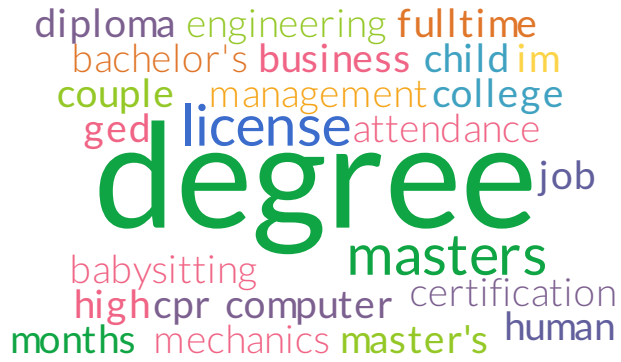

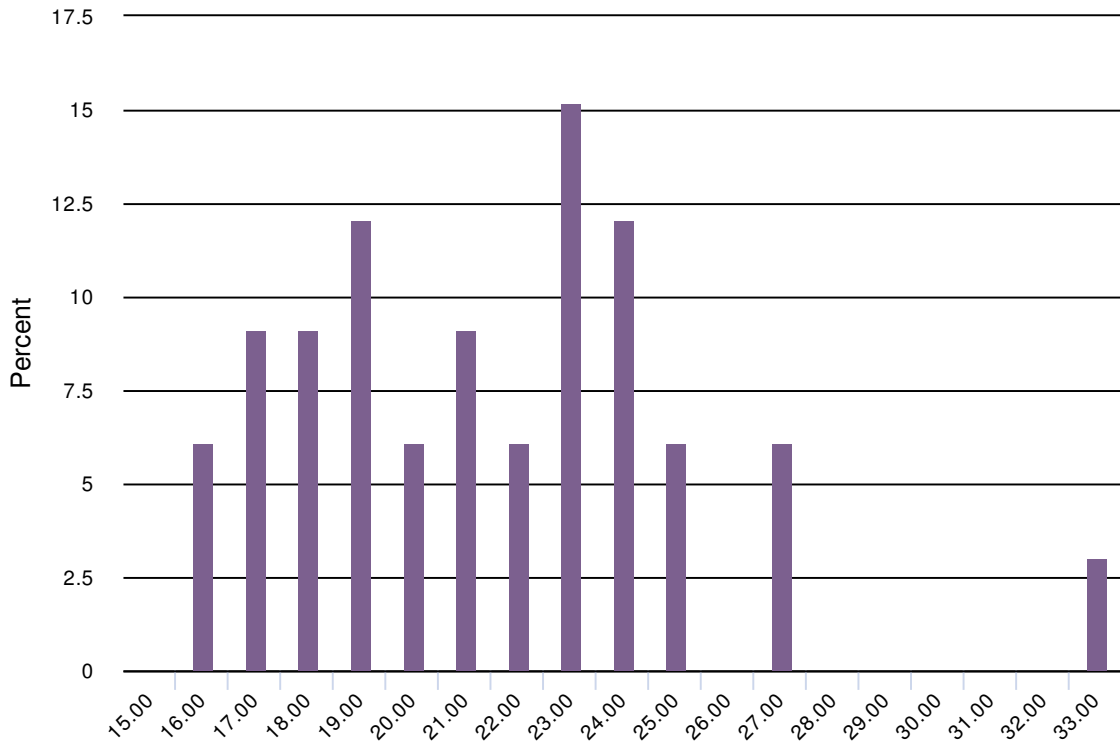
12. What kinds of jobs are you interested in?



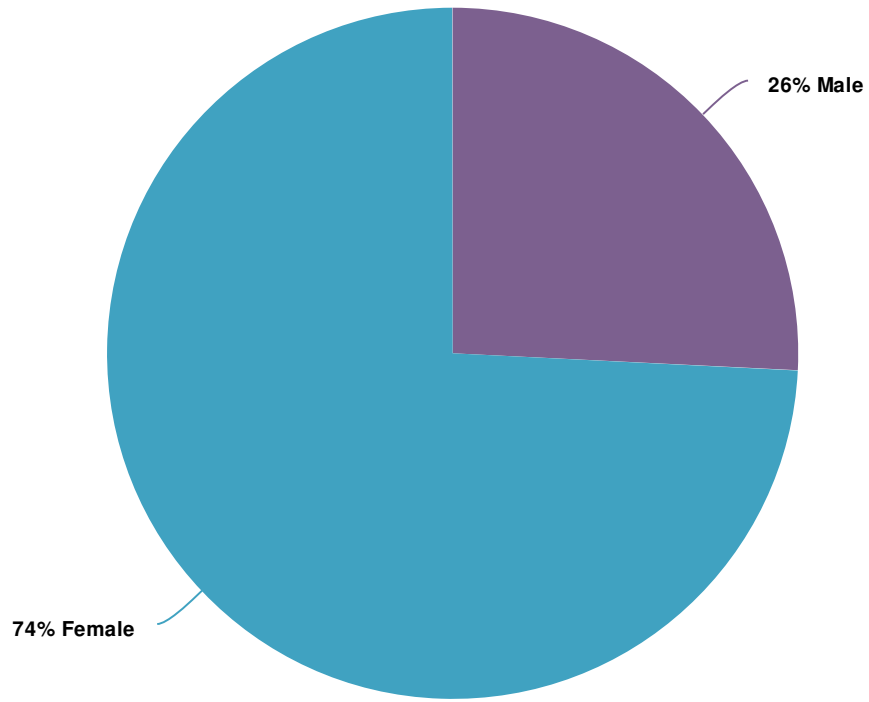

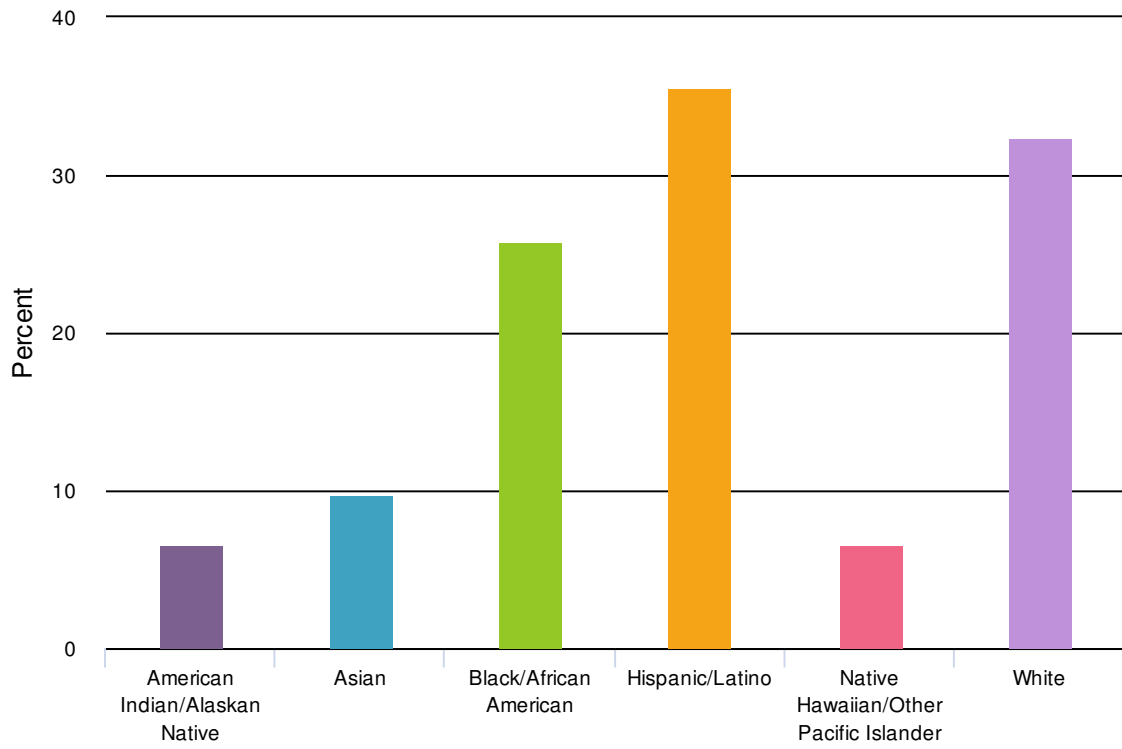

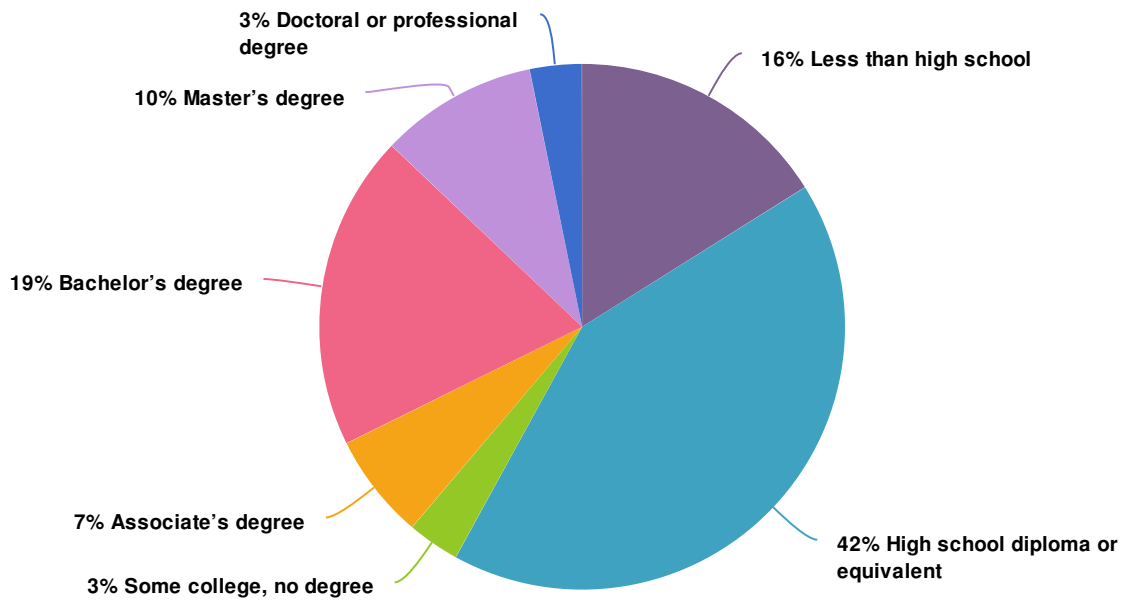

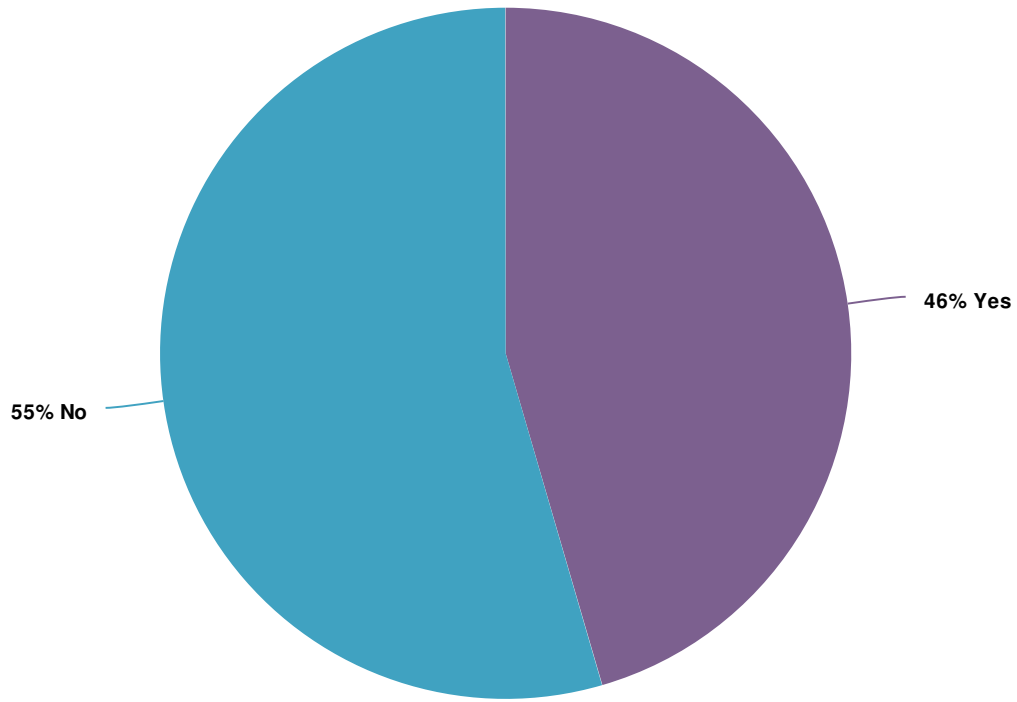
17. Parent or legal guardian's education level

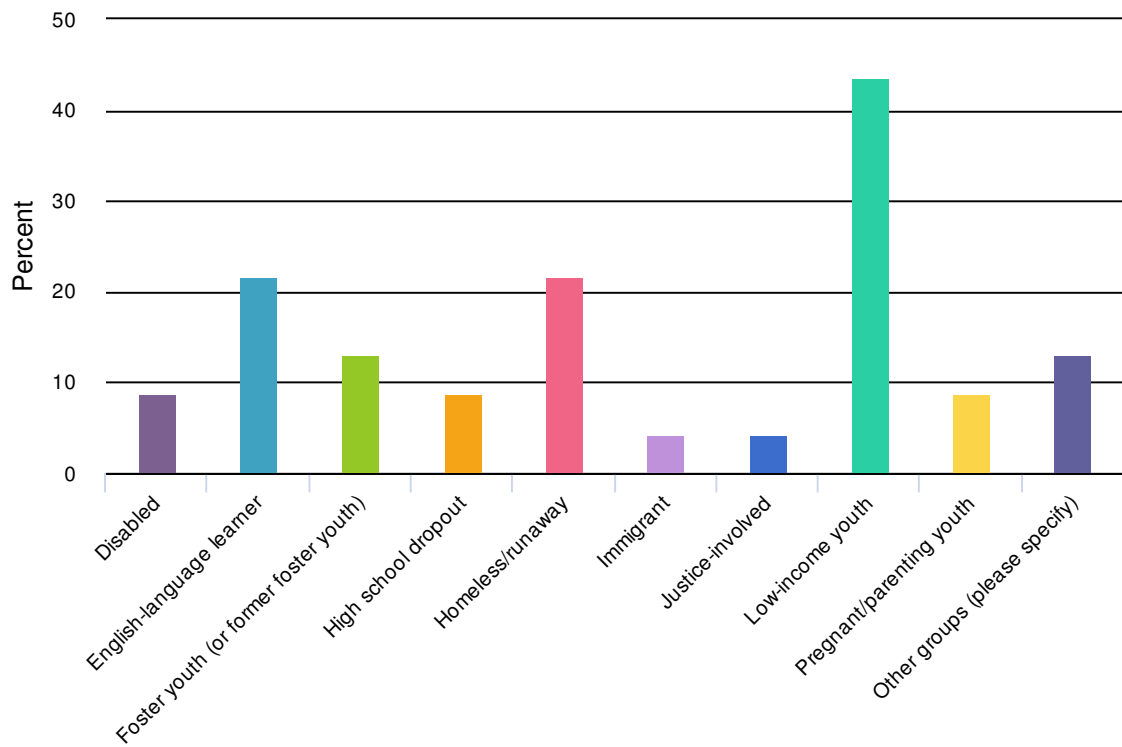

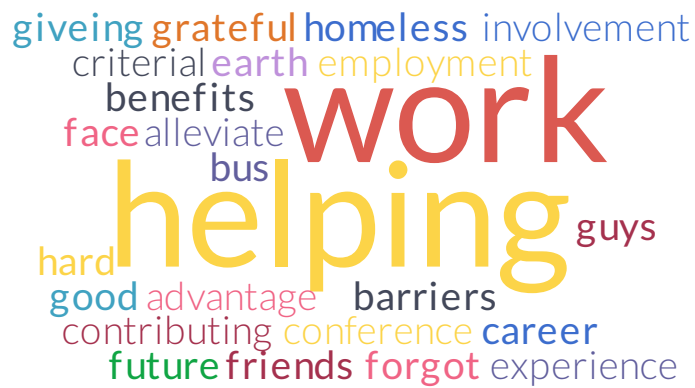
